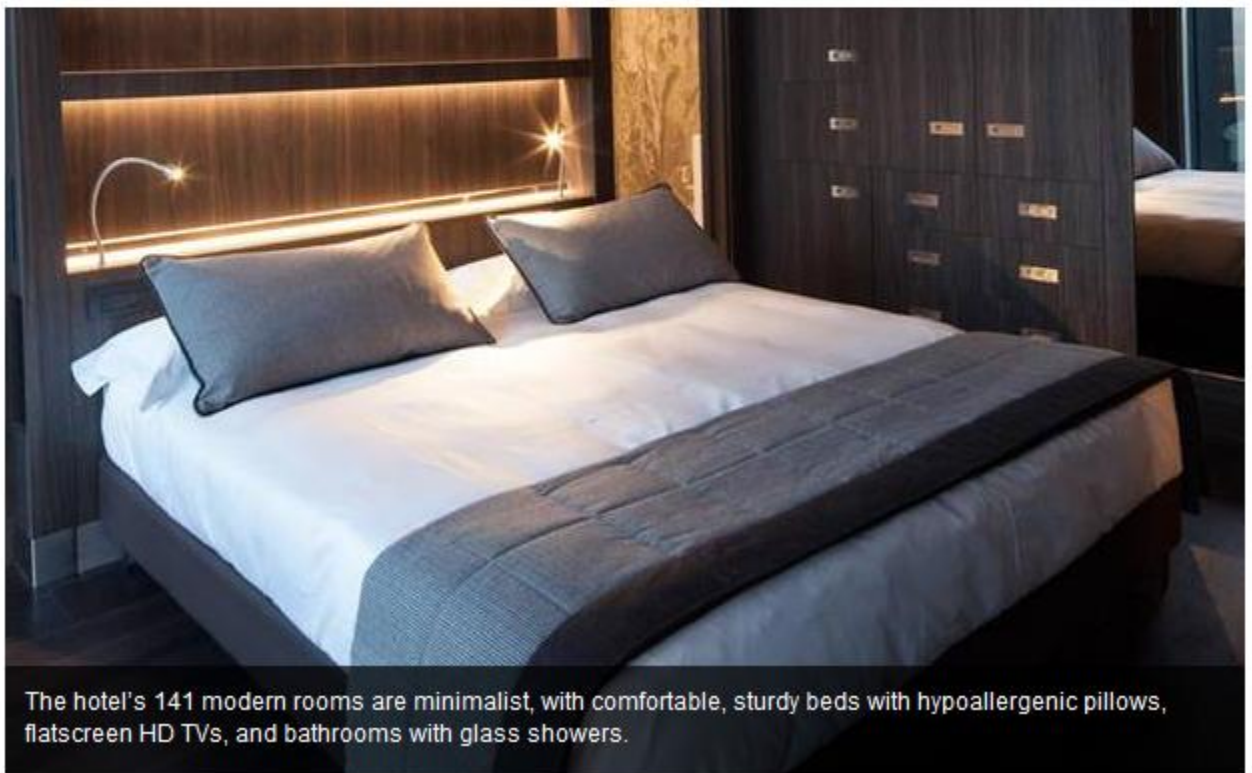

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In the heart of Milan's business district and just a short walk from Milan's main train stations (Stazione Centrale and Porta Garibaldi), this modern hotel is aimed at business travellers. The contemporary rooms feature chocolate-brown furnishings and spacious modern bathrooms. The spa has a fitness area, sauna and steam room, and there's a 13-floor rooftop terrace offering panoramic views of Milan's skyline where weekend brunch and aperitivo are served. The hotel restaurant serves Milanese and international dishes.

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Location



Located in Porta Nuova, Milan's main business district, the hotel is a short walk from Stazione Centrale and Porta Garibaldi railway stations, with high-speed trains to Malpensa airport, as well as national and international destinations. A ten-minute walk away is the up-and-coming district of Isola, home to scores of trendy bars and restaurants. The lively Garibaldi district, lined with shops and fashionable eateries, is also close by.

Style/character



LaGare is a modern business-hotel where stone, glass, wood and steel form an integral part of the design. The welcoming lobby area has leather armchairs and shelves dotted with books, decorative glass and ceramic vases.

Service/facilities



The stylish spa on the lower ground-floor is equipped with a fitness area, sauna, steam room, salt room, chrome and aromatherapy showers, and a relaxation room. The 13th-floor roof terrace is a pleasant spot to soak in the views of Milan's skyline. There are six meeting rooms with a capacity of 200 people, and there is a co-working space with ten desks in the lobby area. A team of young dynamic staff offers friendly and professional service.

Rooms



The hotel's 141 modern rooms have a minimalist design. The Superior rooms have comfortable, sturdy beds with hypoallergenic pillows, flatscreen HD TVs with Sky, and bathrooms with glass showers. The seven Suites are equipped with a separate work area and some have private terraces and bathtubs in the bathrooms.

Food & drink



The buffet breakfast has a good selection of organic local products, while the hotel restaurant, The Bistrot, offers traditional Milanese cuisine as well as a number of fish-based dishes and a handful of international dishes. Weekend brunch and traditional Milanese aperitivo are served on the RoofBar. There is also an informal ground-floor bar and lounge area – a good spot for a post-prandial drink.

Value for money



Double rooms from €119 (£85) in low season; rising to €410 (£292) in high. Breakfast included. Free Wi-Fi.

Access for guests with disabilities?

Yes. The hotel has eight rooms equipped for disabled guests.
